CHAMPAIGN - Funeral services for Jerry M. Jamison, 68, of Champaign will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at Morgan Memorial Home, 1304 Regency Drive West, Savoy. The Rev. Mr. Jamison died at 5:30 p.m. Saturday (Sept. 9, 2006) at home.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister.

Mr. Jamison graduated from Parkland College and attended the University of Illinois and Eastern Illinois University. He was a police officer at the Champaign Police Department and retired in 1991. After he retired, he was a parking attendant at Carle Foundation Hospital South Garage and worked security at MTD in Champaign.
